What is a “Triple A” Board?

A board with a AAA rating is one where every board member is motivated to be an Ambassador, Advocate, and/or Asker. These boards thrive where there is a culture of philanthropy throughout the organization.

The Culture of Philanthropy

- Involves the full "development team"- board, other volunteers, staff and highly engaged donors
- Commitment to mission, vision and values
- An understanding that each interaction with anyone in the community is an opportunity for relationship development with Wally's House
- Staff, board and volunteer(s) understands the importance and purpose of the organization
- Visitors, employees, donors and volunteers feel the culture when they interact with the organization

The Ambassador:

- Has made a financial commitment to the organization
- Is a role everyone should play (staff, board and volunteers)
- Has key roles in relationship building with prospective donors and stewardship of continuing Donor/investors
- Needs to be well-oriented and coached in the message
- Master of the "elevator speech" (and the elevator question)
- Catalyst for donor-investor retention and renewal of gifts

The Advocate:

- Has made a financial commitment to the organization
- On the golf course or the car pool-strategic role in sharing information about the organization
- May also advocate on a more formal basis with city officials, legislators, foundation officers or other community partners. The advocate is willing to take on tough issues or obstacles.
- Is informed about your case for support and understands the strategic plan and vision
- Well coached on desired results of personal advocacy and handling objections

The Asker:

- Has made a financial commitment to the organization
- Enjoys sharing his/her enthusiasm for the organization and asking for an investment
- Well informed, well trained
- "Matched" with prospective donors (or current donor-investors) for maximum possibility of success
- Teamed with another board "Asker" or staff leader
- Staff organizes the ask so the Asker's focus can be on the single purpose of getting (or renewing) the gift
- Benefits from the work of the Ambassadors and Advocates

As an Asker, I will:

- Lead or participate in requests to potential and renewing donors for investment in the organization
 - Sign letters asking for appointments or gifts
 - Send emails to my circle of friends to tell them about Wally's House and ask them to make a contribution
 - Make follow-up phone calls after solicitation letters and/or visits
 - Seek sponsorships for special events and/or promote table purchase by my friends and colleagues
 - Ask local businesses for items to be used as prizes or raffle items for events D Sell tickets for raffles, etc.
