Position Summary

Wally's House is seeking a compassionate Child and Family Therapist to provide trauma-informed mental health services for children and adolescents who have experienced abuse, along with support for their non-offending caregivers. The therapist will provide evidence-based, developmentally appropriate treatment, primarily using Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT), while working collaboratively with caregivers and multidisciplinary team (MDT) partners to promote healing and resilience.

Essential Responsibilities

- Conduct clinical intakes, assessments, and develop treatment plans.
- Provide trauma-focused, evidence-based therapy to children, adolescents, and caregivers.
- Engage caregivers as active partners in treatment.
- Provide crisis intervention and facilitate therapeutic groups as needed.
- Collaborate with MDT partners, schools, medical providers, child welfare, law enforcement, and community agencies.
- Maintain accurate clinical documentation and client confidentiality.
- Participate in peer consultation, continuing education, and quality improvement.
- Assist with agency training, grant reporting, and other duties as assigned.

Requirements

- Master's degree in counseling, psychology, social work, or a related mental health field.
- Oregon licensure preferred; supervision toward licensure is available.
- TF-CBT certification or willingness to complete training.
- Experience providing trauma-informed therapy to children and families preferred.
- Bilingual English/Spanish is a plus.

This is a full-time position with the option of part-time/job-share. Full-time employees are eligible for:
